# HOW TO REGISTER

1- ONLINE: Please visit monroecamp.org/summer and click on the link that states "Summer Camp Online Registration." Follow the online registration process, make payment online and an E-mail Confirmation Packet will be sent to you to fill out before you arrive.

2- MAIL: Fill out the paper copy of "2015 Monroe Summer Camp Registration Form." Send a \$50 non-refundable deposit and the registration form to: MCRC, 24501 Camp Rd., Laurel Hill, NC 28351.

Full camp fees are due 7 days after Confirmation Packet is received. Registration received 30 days or less before your child's camp starts MUST be paid in full at time of registration.

**REFUND/CANCELLATION POLICY:** Refunds, minus the deposit will be made if a cancellation is received 14 days or more before your registered camp begins. Cancellations received 14 days or less from camp date will receive 50% refund. No shows on the day camp begins forfeit their registration fees. Requests for refunds due to illness or accidents must be accompanied by a doctor's note. No refund will be issued for early departure from a camp due to a camper violation of policy (e.g. possession of tobacco) or for reasons of personal choice (e.g. homesickness).

## TIER PRICING: WHY 3 PRICES?

Realizing that families have different abilities to pay, Monroe Camp and Retreat Center has instituted a voluntary three-tier fee program. You may choose the tier that is most suitable for your family. All campers receive the same Monroe Camp experience no matter what they pay. For those families that cannot afford Tier I, additional financial assistance is available to ensure that all children have this wonderful opportunity to attend camp.

- Tier I is our historically subsidized rate and does not reflect the true cost of operating summer camp programs.
- Tier II is our partially subsidized fee for those who can pay a little more but still cannot afford the actual cost of camp.
- Tier III more closely accounts for the true costs of camp including wear and tear of building and grounds.

OUR GOALS WITH TIER PRICING are: 1) to provide the highest quality programs possible, 2) to serve all community income levels, and, 3) to preserve camp for generations to come. Again this program is voluntary and in no way influences the experience children receive, yet it offers the opportunity for families to take an active role in supporting the true cost of their child's camp experience.
