Wait List

If the camp you wish to register for is full, we encourage you to place the child on a wait list. Should a spot become available, you will receive an email notifying you of the opening. You will have 48 hours to make a payment to reserve the child's spot.



Health Form

The online health form must be completed prior to the start of camp. Completed health forms are required for each camper. Families will need immunization records and insurance information for this section.

Camp Monroe staff are selected based on experience, maturity and dedication to their Christian principals and guiding campers on their own faith journeys for Christ. All staff are screened with a background check, sexoffender registry check, central registry clearance (for child abuse/neglect) and a driving record check. Each staff member is certified in First Aid and CPR and has participated in Camp Monroe Staff Training. We hope you will find our staff to be committed to providing an outstanding experience for your child.


Cancellation Policy

30+ Days Notice: If a cancellation is made MORE than 30 days prior to the camp start date, any payment made above the initial deposit will be refunded (if requested).

If a cancellation is made LESS than 30 days prior to the camp start date, no refund will be given, and the following applies.

- 15-29 Days Notice: Any cancellation received more than two weeks out (15-29 days) before your camp start date will receive a full credit for the amount paid above your deposit and registration fee.
- Less than 14 Days Notice: Any cancellation OR transfer within 14 days from your camp start date will result in funds being forfeited.


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Tracks & Program Activities

Tracks

- 1. Adventure Track for the camper who has tons of energy and loves rollercoasters, this track guarantees that the camper will get to spend each week on the giant swing, zip line, race up our climbing tower, and complete our high ropes course challenge.
